



Terms & Conditions

for Le Trip 2027

Organised by Simply Motor Events LTD

These Terms & Conditions (“Terms”) form the contract between you (“Participant”) and Simply Motor Events (“the Organiser”) in respect of your participation in Le Trip (“the Event”). By booking a place or paying the deposit you agree to be bound by these Terms.

1. Definitions

- Event: the “Le Trip” group car holiday taking place from Sunday 13th June 2027 to Tuesday 23rd June 2027.
- Participant: any driver or passenger registered to take part in the Event.
- Vehicle: the car(s) used by Participants during the Event.
- Booking: the reservation for the Event once the deposit is received.

2. Booking & Payment

The total cost of the Tour is £2995 per car, based on two sharing.

A non-refundable deposit of £500 per vehicle is required no later than 30th September 2026 to secure a booking place.

- The balance of the total cost must be paid by 28th February 2027
- If the balance is not received by this date the Organiser may cancel the booking and retain the deposit.
- Payments are accepted by Bank Transfer, Credit Card (Fees will apply).
- Payments can be spread over a set amount of months, September to February, £500 monthly.

3. Participant Changes

- You may transfer your booking to another person/vehicle up to 12 weeks before the Event, subject to the Organiser’s approval and an administration fee of £100.
- Changes after that date cannot be guaranteed and may incur extra charges.

4. Cancellation by Participants

- Cancellations must be in writing.
- The £500 deposit is non-refundable.
- Additional cancellation charges apply to the total cost:
 - More than 16 weeks: Deposit only
 - 16 - 10 weeks: 50% of total cost
 - Less than 10 weeks: 100% of total cost.

5. Cancellation or Changes by the Organiser

- The Organiser may alter routes, accommodation or schedules if necessary (e.g. force majeure, road closures, weather).
- If the Event is cancelled by the Organiser, all monies paid will be refunded except for non-recoverable supplier costs, e.g. hotels, crossings and expenses.

6. Insurance, Documentation & Legal Requirements

- Participants must hold valid motor insurance covering the Vehicle for the entire trip, including international travel where relevant.
- The vehicle must be road-legal with valid MOT, tax, and meet the legal requirements of all countries visited.
- Drivers must carry valid driving licences and any travel documents (passports, visas, etc.).
- Participants are strongly advised to have personal travel insurance (covering medical expenses, cancellation, repatriation) and European breakdown cover.

7. Vehicle Condition, Safety & Conduct

- Vehicles must be in a safe, roadworthy condition. The Organiser may refuse entry if a vehicle is deemed unsafe.
- All participants must comply with the road laws of each country visited and drive at their own risk.
- The Organiser may issue convoy or safety rules; serious breach of these rules may result in removal from the event without refund.

8. Liability & Indemnity

- To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Organiser's liability is limited to the amount paid for the event.
- The Organiser is not liable for indirect losses (e.g. loss of earnings, damage to property not caused by its negligence).
- Participants agree to indemnify the Organiser against third-party claims, fines or expenses arising from their participation or use of their Vehicle.

9. Risk Acknowledgement

- Participants acknowledge that participation in a group driving event carries inherent risks (traffic accidents, breakdowns, adverse weather, etc.).
- Participants accept these risks and agree not to hold the Organiser responsible for injury, loss or damage except where caused by the Organiser's negligence.

10. Data & Publicity

- By taking part you consent to photos and video being taken during the Event for use in publicity or marketing by the Organiser, unless you notify the Organiser in writing before the Event.
- Personal data will be processed in accordance with applicable UK data protection laws (including UK GDPR).

11. Amendments

- The Organiser may update these Terms from time to time and will notify Participants by email.
- Continued participation after notification constitutes acceptance of any changes.

12. Governing Law

- These Terms are governed by the laws of England and Wales and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.

13. Entire Agreement

These Terms constitute the entire agreement between the Organiser and Participant and supersede any prior understandings.
